



Prescott National Cemetery Announced as an Official Location for the 2018 National Wreaths Across America Day

Saturday, Dec. 15, 2018, at 10 a.m.*

National nonprofit Wreaths Across America (WAA) announced today that Prescott National Cemetery in Prescott, Arizona has once again joined the effort to support the mission. Remembering, Honoring and Teaching the community about Wreaths Across America. Prescott National Cemetery will participate in this national event.

The goal for the Prescott National Cemetery is to raise enough funds to place 3300 remembrance wreaths on the headstones of all the local heroes laid to rest there. This will ensure that the individuals who served to protect the freedoms of our country will never be forgotten and to bring the community together in patriotic commemoration.

Due to construction at the Prescott National Cemetery there is no parking available. Instead the VA Hospital is providing shuttle service from the VA Hospital to the Cemetery. Signage for parking will be posted at the VA Hospital. The ceremony will begin at 10 a.m. regardless of weather conditions. Please dress accordingly.
