HSD/A HAND UP HOUSING COUNSELING PROGRAM

Our housing counselors provide expert housing and financial counseling and education. We'll help you better understand your finances, learn how to reach your housing and financial goals, and help you avoid foreclosure.

Programs include: Classes on home buying (certified), DIY home maintenance and financial capabilities; Counseling on budgeting, pre-purchase, **mortgage delinquency** and default resolution, rental and homelessness, and reserve mortgage.

We also provide education on your fair housing rights and responsibilities. You have the right to choose where you want to live. If you feel you have been a victim of fair housing discrimination, we can help.
